Enhanced flu/RSV seasonal monitoring paused as of 5/23/2026; resumes in October. COVID-19 is tracked year-round.

El Paso County (local)

Communicable Disease Data Dashboard last updated 7/8/2026 (updates monthly, second Wednesday). No local conditions currently flagged as elevated.

The "What's Going Around" bimonthly bulletin — the county's usual channel for calling out specific circulating illnesses (strep, norovirus, hand-foot-mouth, etc.) — has not published a new issue since **September 20, 2025**. It appears to have been discontinued, so this source currently offers no signal either way. Worth checking manually if you want more granular local detail.

Bottom line

Nothing concerning as of this check. No action needed on exposure risk right now.
