

Colorado Springs School Illness Watch

Snapshot as of August 14, 2026

SUMMARY

NO CHANGE

No change since the last check on August 13, 2026. Statewide respiratory illness activity (COVID-19, flu, RSV) remains **Very Low**, per CDPHE's weekly update (last refreshed 8/12/2026). El Paso County's communicable disease dashboard is also unchanged (last refreshed 8/12/2026), and the county's "What's Going Around" bulletin remains discontinued — its most recent issue is still the one from September 20, 2025. Nothing new to act on today.
