CDPHE UNCHANGED

EL PASO COUNTY UNCHANGED

No change today. CDPHE's statewide data is still on its 9/9/2026 weekly update, with overall respiratory illness activity in Colorado holding at **Very Low** and all ED-visit, sentinel-positivity, and wastewater figures identical to the last several checks (SARS-CoV-2 rising in 10/21 monitored utilities, flu in 0/21, RSV in 1/21). El Paso County's dashboard is also unchanged (still dated 9/9/2026), and the "What's Going Around" bulletin remains discontinued (no issue since Sept. 20, 2025).
