CDPHE UNCHANGED

EL PASO COUNTY UNCHANGED

No change since yesterday's check. CDPHE's statewide report is still showing its 9/16/2026 weekly update (next refresh expected Wednesday 9/23), with overall respiratory illness activity in Colorado holding at **Very Low** and the same COVID/flu/RSV figures as the last check. El Paso County's Communicable Disease Data Dashboard and "What's Going Around" bulletin are also unchanged — no new local report.
